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**SUBJECT - 2010 Coolangatta Gold Junior Endurance Iron Person Event
Entry Bulletin and Conditions of Entry**

The 2010 Junior Coolangatta Gold Endurance Ironperson Event/s will be conducted in conjunction the 2010 Coolangatta Gold on Sunday 7th November 2010 at Kurrawa Beach. The 2010 Junior Coolangatta Gold Endurance Ironperson Event/s will be for U14, U15 and U17 Male & Female competitors (age groups for the 2010/2011 season).

ENTRY FEE: \$33.00 (including GST)

ENTRIES CLOSE: Wednesday 27th October 2010

A late entry fee of \$55.00 (plus the entry fee of \$33) inc of GST, will apply to all those athletes who wish to enter after this date. Late entries close at 5pm on Monday 1st November 2010.

NB: No late entries will be accepted after this date.

REGISTRATION / BREIFING:

Registration of attendance is compulsory for all entered competitors on the morning of the event. All competitors will be issued with a race number at this registration and will be required to mark clearly their numbers on both arms and legs. Competitors may be issued with sponsor stickers, which must be applied to all craft. The race briefing is also compulsory for all competitors (in all age groups) along with their handlers and will take place at 8.15am on Sunday 7th November 2010 at waters edge on Kurrawa Beach. The draw for order of legs will take place at this briefing.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

All competitors must complete the entry form (in full) and pay the entry fee. Please note that SLSQ members can complete the entry process through SLSQ's Carnival manager electronic system via their club administrators and/ or Team Managers. The event coordinators reserve the right to reject or cancel any entry at any time.

Interstate competitors must have their club and state endorsement by way of a letter attached to the entry form.

Section 3 (Elite/Special Competition) of the SLSA Competition Sponsorship Policy will apply to this event. All competitors must hold the appropriate award for their 2010/2011 age category, be proficient and be a current financial member of their surf life saving club for the 2010/2011 season.

All competitors must wear their club competition cap and club swimwear whilst competing. All handlers are required to wear the same competition cap and swimwear as that of their competitor.

NB: as this event is associated with an SLSA marquee" event, all handlers MUST be dressed in clearly identified "club" uniform. No board shorts will be allowed.

The SLSA competition manual will apply to all races except where stated in this and subsequent documents. All craft must meet SLSA surf craft specifications. SLSA reserves the right to alter or change the venue or course should conditions warrant.

All handlers must be financial members of the competitors surf life saving club (unless the event referee has granted permission of a member of another club to perform the duties of the handler).

PROCEDURE FOR IRONPERSON EVENT/S (Board and Swim only):

Ballot for the board and swim will be conducted during the competitor briefing.

For the purpose of this description the order will be Board, Run then Swim and the final run to the finish. The course is right hand in and is illustrated in the following diagram.

(a) Board Course - The Board leg is conducted from the start line, around the swim buoys and the two board buoys, return to the beach proceed around the turning flag then proceed back out to sea around the second set of swim buoys and the two board buoys before returning to the beach. (M shaped course)

Distances:

U14 – 350m to board buoy

U15 & U17 – 450m to board buoy

(b) Run Leg - Upon returning to shore the competitors will run around the turning flag and proceed north to the turning flag at the other end of the course. Competitors shall then turn around the flag and commence south to complete two more lengths of the beach i.e.; down then back after turning the flag at the finish end of the board leg (3 lengths of the beach in total). Competitors will then round the flag again at the start area and proceed into the water for the swim leg

(c) Swim Course - The Swim leg is conducted from the start change over line, around the swimming buoys, return to the beach, proceed around the turning flag and proceed back out to sea around the second set of swim buoys and return to shore. (M shaped course)

Distances:

U14 – 150m to swim buoy

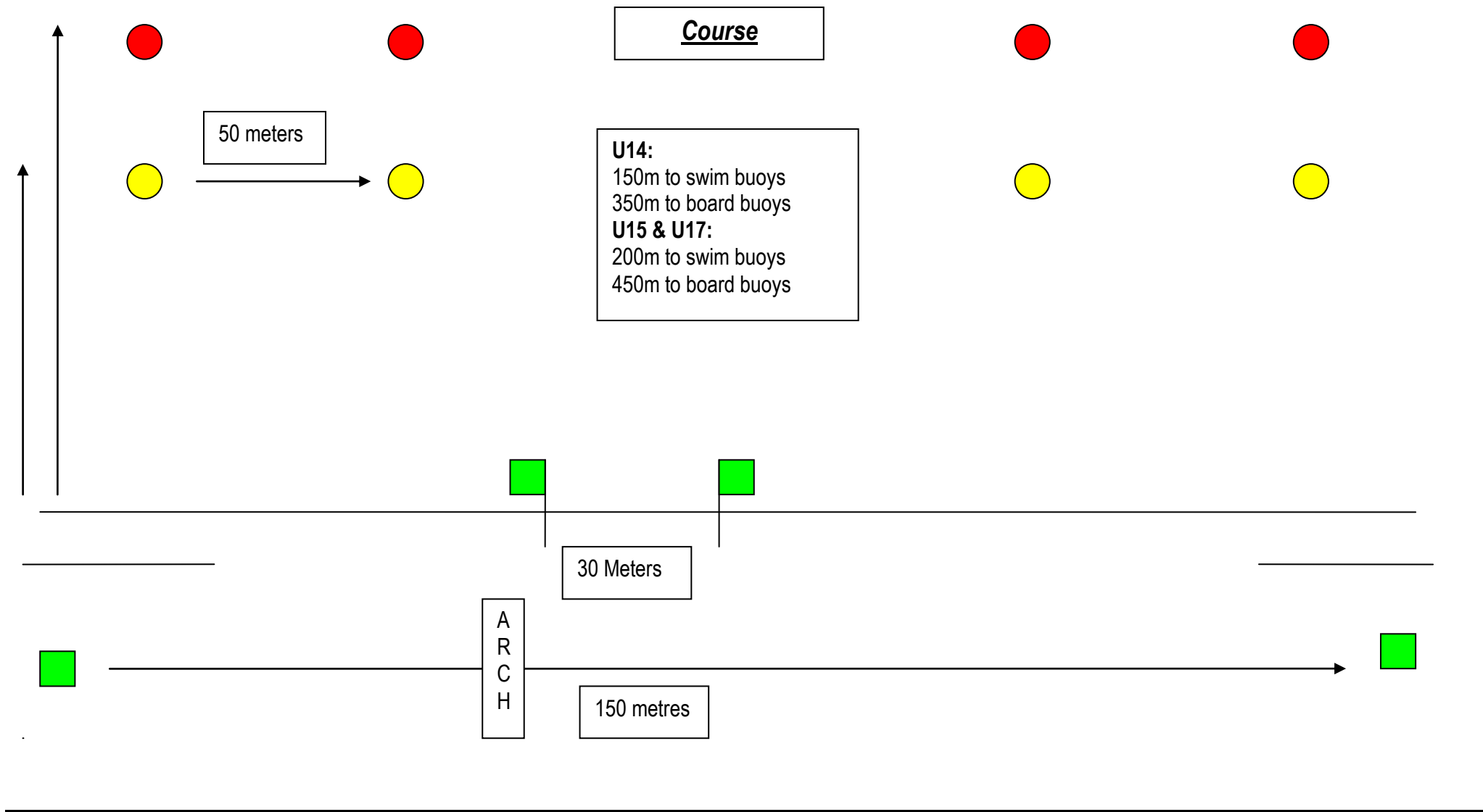
U15 & U17 – 200m to swim buoy

(d) Once they return to shore competitors shall complete the course by rounding the turning flag running under the finish arch.

NB: The event manager and/or JCG event referee, reserves the right to alter the attached course design/layout at his/her discretion depending on time frames available and conditions – on the day.

MEDALS and TROPHIES:

1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th place getters in each event will receive trophies and or medals
