SUBJECT: Use of Club Equipment, Gym/Facilities, Club Activities prior to completion of Cert II/SRC.

The following policy statement was presented to the Mooloolaba Executive Management Committee via email and consensus obtained for adoption as Policy from 7 September 2013:

POLICY

BACKGROUND:

The following policy has been prepared to clearly communicate the guideline for use of club equipment (eg; rescue boards), use of club facilities (eg; gym), endorsed club aquatic activities (eg; ins & outs) to those members who are enrolled or undertaking the Certificate II (Bronze) or SRC award.

It is required that these members have prior to the commencement of the course, completed the blue card application, (at enrolment time, some 3-4 weeks prior) and this application will be in progress of processing with the State Government Authority and be nearing return advice by the time the pool swim is to be undertaken.

DIRECTION:

Members who are financial and have enrolled into a Certificate II (Bronze) or SRC award and who have not competently completed the pool swim are not allowed to utilise any club equipment (rescue boards), facilities (gym) or club aquatic activities (ins & outs).

Members who are financial and have enrolled into a Certificate II (Bronze) or SRC award and who have competently completed the pool swim (are yet to complete the course) may under the supervision of a qualified trainer with suitable water safety and PPE, undertake rescue board training, ins & outs and shall have access via proximity device to the gym.
